Francisco de Esquivel/ license to ship six slaves to the Española/	+ The King / r our officials of the Casa de la Contratación de las Indias / who reside in the city of Seville, may you know that I have / given license and hereby I grant it to Francisco de Esquivel / so that he or whoever has his power may ship to the / Española island six black male slaves that have been Christian / for two years. Therefore I order you to allow and consent the said Francisco de Esquivel or whoever may have his power, with the limitations and conditions that are mandated, / without raising any impediment or obstacle or / any prohibition there may be otherwise, / after first registering this <i>cédula</i> of mine to you. / Done in Burgos on the fifteenth of June of / five hundred fifteen. / I the King. Certified by the secretary Conchillos. Signed / by the Bishop of Burgos. /
